To Whom It May Concern:

We lost our sweet Roman Brooks Woodward on November 30, 2023. He was delivered stillborn due to his mother suffering a placenta abruption. It was heartbreaking.

Although a Cuddle Cot (a bassinet type device used to preserve the baby) was offered and used, it did not extend to when Roman was held. All any of us (Mom, Dad, and grandparents) wanted to do was hold him as long as possible, but in doing so, he deteriorated and needed to be placed back in the Cuddle Cot.

Experiencing and witnessing this led to the creation of Roman's Wrap; something to enable families to hold their babies longer. Roman's Wrap is a soft, comforting blanket with a pocket on its inner lining to hold a flexible ice pack. The outside of the blanket is a soft flannel or Minky fabric. This allows the baby to be held comfortably and yet be preserved longer, affording the precious gift of time. We hope this wrap will provide some comfort in the most unimaginable, heartbreaking of times; the loss of a sweet child.

We would like to **donate** Roman's Wraps to your hospital to then be offered to the grieving families to use and keep as a memory if that brings them comfort. Roman's Wraps are 30 X 30 inches square for full term babies or roughly 20 X 20 inches square for premature babies. The ice packs are custom-fitted for each size. When selecting a flexible ice pack for the larger wrap, the ice pack must fit in a 12 X 16 inch pocket. On the smaller wrap, the ice packet must fit in a 9 X 13 inch pocket. We would suggest purchasing two ice packs for each Roman Wrap so it can be interchangeable and refrozen while in use. The ice packs we suggest are Flexikold gel Ice packs - large for the 30" Romans Wrap and medium for the 20" Romans Wrap. To date, 341 Roman's Wraps have been donated in hospitals in Wisconsin, Illinois, Missouri, Florida, South Dakota, North Carolina, Alabama, Texas and Tennessee. One recipient/mother shared, ***"We received one of Roman's Wraps in the hospital this week as we spent time with our son. He was with us for 9 hours, and because of Roman's Wrap, we were able to cuddle and hold him after he passed, which gave us great comfort."*** A labor and delivery nurse shared, ***"Working as a Labor and Delivery nurse and using one of Roman's Wraps for a patient tonight. Despite the circumstances, it's a blessing to have these available at our hospital. I was telling my coworker about the wraps and how wonderful it would be to have one for our situation, only to find that we do have a supply and this will be the first time one gets used."***
